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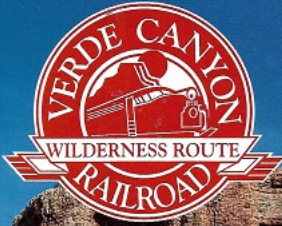

Excursion trains depart from

Verde Canyon Railroad's depot in Clarkdale year-round; however, the schedule, which varies according to seasons, is subject to necessary change. Please call **1-800-293-7245** or visit www.verdecanyonrr.com for the latest update regarding departure times, and to make **advance reservations, which are required.** Boarding is at 300 N. Broadway, Clarkdale, AZ 86324, which is two hours north of Phoenix, one hour southwest of Flagstaff and 25 minutes west of Sedona.

First-class cars feature living room-style seating, complimentary appetizers, beverage service to all seats, a cash bar and fewer passengers. **Coach** cars provide Pullman-style seating with two seats on each side of a center aisle, as well as a snack bar. All of Verde Canyon Railroad's cars are pulled by vintage FP7 engines, of which there are only 12 such models remaining in North America. The passenger cars are climate-controlled with restrooms, meet ADA requirements, provide convenient access to **open-air** viewing cars, and feature historic narration and live music.

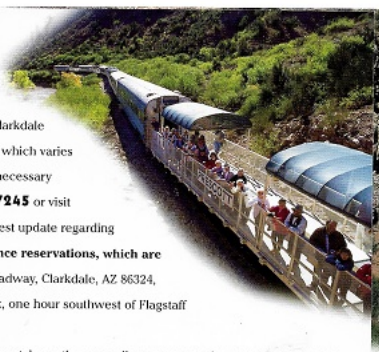
Food and beverage service is provided at the depot; snacks and beverages are available on the train. No coolers or hard-pack containers, strollers or large carry-ons are allowed, and both the train and depot are non-smoking facilities.

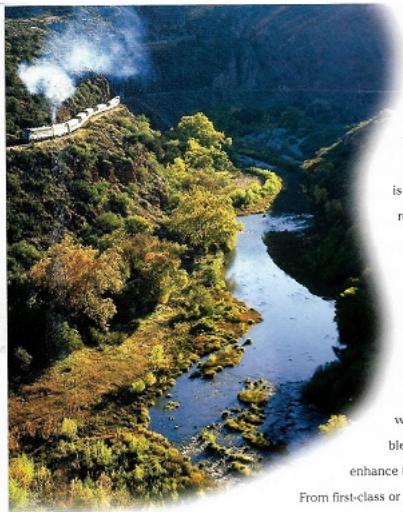
Information regarding special **"Room and ride"** packages at resorts, inns and motels in Sedona and surrounding communities is available upon request.

IT'S NOT THE DESTINATIC

A ride on **Verde Canyon Railroad's historic route** from Clarkdale to Perkinsville and back — into Arizona's other "grand canyon" — is an unforgettable experience.

Verde Canyon, home of America's national symbol, the **bald eagle**, is accessible only by rail and features flora and fauna; rugged, high-desert rock faces; and spectacular, panoramic views totally distinctive to this unique, geological area.

Passengers on this popular excursion train are enthralled as the eagle-decorated, vintage engine rolls past towering, crimson cliffs; near ancient Indian ruins; over old-fashioned trestles; and through a dark, 680-foot, man-made tunnel on a four-hour round trip to deserted **Perkinsville Ranch** and back.

This historic route — between two national forests and adjacent to a wilderness area — follows the upper **Verde River**, a lush riparian habitat blessed with astonishing beauty. And during the summer, **Starlight Tours** enhance the lure of this unique route.

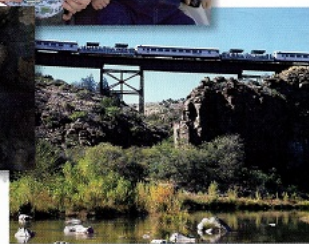
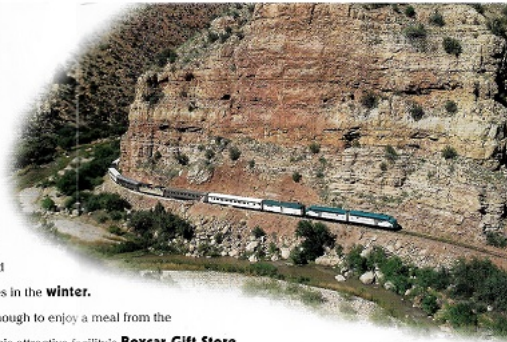
cars, where they savor Arizona's special brand of fresh air — and from these platform cars with colorful canopies, they bask in the delightful sights, sounds and smells of the high desert that characterizes Verde Canyon.

Here, every season offers an exceptional treat: wildflowers and blooming cactuses — and waterfalls, perhaps — in the **spring**; black hawks, great blue herons and massive cottonwoods in the **summer**; brightly colored riparian foliage in the **fall**; and both bald and golden eagles in the **winter**.

Plan to arrive at Verde Canyon Railroad's depot early enough to enjoy a meal from the outdoor grill at the **Copper Spike Cafe** and browse in this attractive facility's **Boxcar Gift Store** — and leave time to enjoy an intriguing exhibit of photographs and memorabilia related to the history of this railroad, which gave birth to one of Arizona's earliest towns.

Verde Canyon Railroad, nestled in the heart of the sprawling Verde Valley, is ideally situated above the heat of the desert and below the cold of Arizona's high country. Indeed, this railroad is a year-round, four-seasons attraction.
