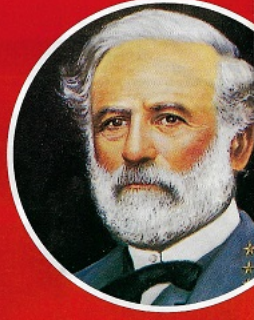


VZPOMÍNKA (65) -
