The Herbert Hoover Presidential Library and Museum enables visitors to experience for themselves the many sides of Iowa's only President. The tour begins in a rotunda area with a 16 foot red granite map of the world. Move on to exciting displays of the Australian outback, China at the turn of the century, a Belgian relief warehouse during the first World War, and the Inaugural Platform on March 4, 1929. Drop by the President's fishing cabin and watch Mrs. Hoover's home movies, and then visit Suite 31A at the Waldorf Towers where Mr. Hoover spent the last years of his life.

Fees

Visitors to the Hoover Museum pay a single fee which admits them to all museum exhibits, President Hoover's birthplace, his father's blacksmith shop, Quaker meeting house, the local schoolhouse, and the Hoover's gravesite. Admission for adults 17-61 is \$3; senior citizens 62 and over are \$1; and children under 17 are free.

Changing Exhibits

In the Quarton Gallery the Museum offers exciting temporary exhibits relating to American history.

The Museum Store

The Museum gift shop has unique souvenirs for the history buff as well as Christmas ornaments and Iowa souvenirs.

The Hoover Presidential Library-Museum is one of ten such institutions operated by the National Archives and Records Administration.

The museum is located just off I-80 at Exit 254. Open daily
