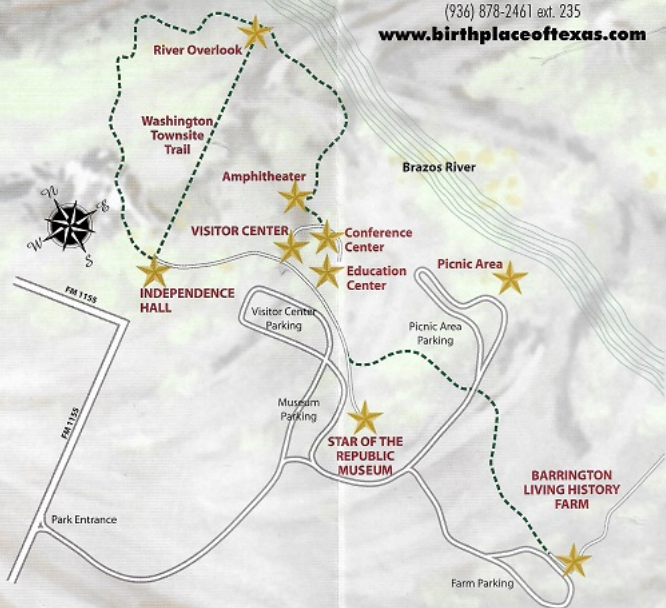


March 2, 1836

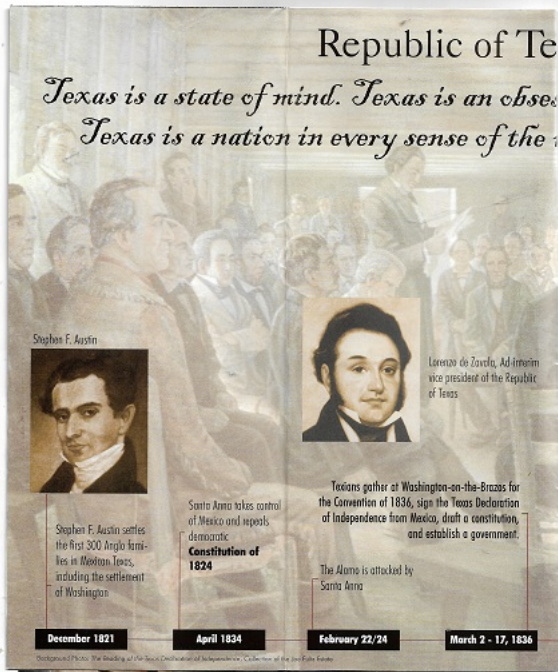

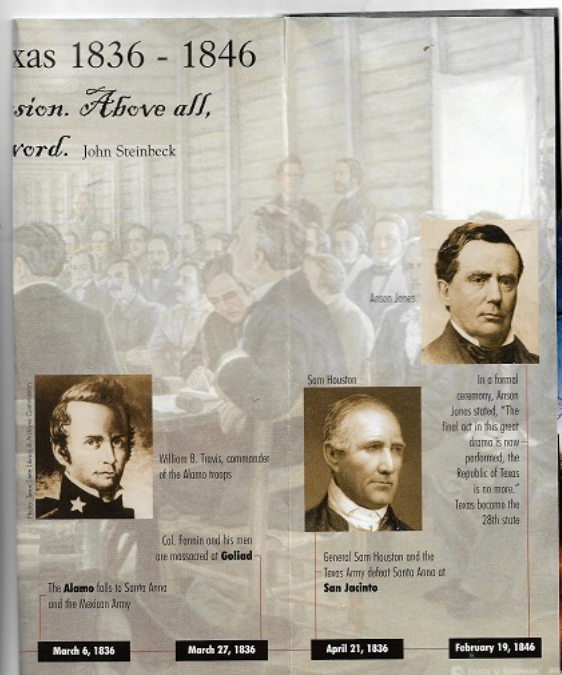
